

Job Title: Summer Program Educator

Position Overview:

Summer Program Educators teach STEAM curriculum while supervising a group of students, providing leadership, content, and ensuring a fun safe learning environment. Educators present educational activities in a fun, engaging manner that sparks student interest, while ensuring tools and materials are used correctly. Aside from leading activities, educators are also responsible for leading free time activities and ensuring the safety and well-being of students.

Essential Job Functions:

- Direct supervision and leadership of up to 16 students per week.
- Effectively and safely teach STEAM education skills and supervise a group of students during on campus activity blocks and free time as an educator
- Deliver Course Curriculum
 - Instruction and facilitation of course workshops and activities
 - Demonstrate various technique and tools
 - Set up and maintain equipment
- Provide a safe, positive and supportive environment for students to challenge themselves
 - o Encourage students to come up with new and innovative ideas
 - Promote collaboration and teamwork
 - Create and supervise emotionally healthy environment for students
 - Lead team building activities to develop community and respect
- Manage student health and safety:
 - Utilize approved safety practices in all activities and non-program supervision time
 - Escort and oversee students
 - Checking on children with medical needs to ensure they have taken any required medication
 - Manage student allergies or medical needs
 - o Provide appropriate First Aid and submit written reports to Health Supervisor
- Organize recreational activities, supervising to ensure student safety, explaining rules, and acting as referee as needed.
- Maintain a tidy and orderly classroom
- Participate in staff meetings and training sessions

Other Job Duties:

- Assist with arrivals and departures of students
- Take pictures of students and activities for use in marketing and social media
- Light cleaning of the classroom and facility as needed
- Communicate directly with parents as needed.
- Complete designated paperwork, reports, etc.

- Rotate through program support duties and community jobs including general cleaning, dishes, and program support
- Other duties as assigned as an educator

Working Environment:
